*[ SENIOR COACHES REPORT ]*

Dear Members,

As we are hitting the mid stage of the season its time to keep you all informed of our progress of the teams that are representing East Torrens Payneham.

With the Men's League team so far I can say we are under achieving with results and have been damn unlucky with some very close results so far. The team has 3 wins, 5 losses and 1 draw with two results determined within the last 3 seconds of the game, 9-9 draw with the Bays and a disappointing 8-9 loss to West Torrens (better result than first round). Take six seconds away and we are looking a little better with 4-4-1 and would keep us in touch. We have two important games before the break and with possible wins against Nth Adelaide and Brighton we will keep the pressure on all teams above us leading into September.

This year sees the return of an ETP Women's B Grade team. The team has been made up of a determined group of players consisting of a wide range of lacrosse backgrounds. It is encouraging to see so many new faces in this team, and as they improve in every game they are getting closer to the top 4.

The Men's Reserves have had a great season so far and are travelling undefeated and have some great results in round one against Brighton and Sturt, both of which are very good sides in this comp. With the way our Reserves are travelling they are certain for September action and should give it a great shake. Their record so far is 9-0 and looking good.

The Men's B grade team is struggling with numbers and little support but are very serviceable with their efforts so far. Their record is 2-4-1 and if they can attract a few more players then there is a good chance the B Grade side will make the finals and give the opposition a real shake around September.

From my coaching development this season it's been very frustrating and I have learnt a heap about people and what to expect from people and time they can allocate to lacrosse. There are small windows of opportunity in sport and the club is right there now. But taking a step back and looking at the seniors in general the teams are stronger and the club is stronger on the field. We have been unlucky with some long-term injuries and we also have been short of a permanent coach for the B Grade to help organize this team, with this we could be a much stronger side. We also need to look to the future with junior development before too long and have teams that are all ETP players running out and representing the Redwings.
