The first session for players was held on Sunday January 16<sup>th</sup>, at Langman Reserve, Felixstow, and the second session will be held at **West Beach, behind the Caravan Park on Sunday January 23<sup>rd</sup> at 10am**. The first fitness assessment will be the commencement of a 6 week fitness program to be run by Lynton Arscott. All players are to make themselves available for each session. This program will be monitored by Lynton and recommendations to coaches on fitness and injury will be referred to by Lynton.
